SEASONAL INDOOR COURT TIMES AVAILABLE

If you have a group of players who you normally play with on a regular basis, you may book the indoor courts on our seasonal court reservation system. This is how it works:

A seasonal court time may be booked for a period of sixteen weeks (beginning the week of September 4). All you pay is \$136.00 plus tax per person (based on four people), and the court is guaranteed at that time for 16 weeks. After the 16 weeks you may rehire under the seasonal court time contract or let that time go to someone else. As an added bonus, if you bring guests and you are on the seasonal contract, there will be no guest fee charged. If you enjoy playing tennis at the same time each week and don't want the possibility of weather problems, please call Tennis Shop at 817-294-6690.

Cilantro Chimichurri

Chimichurri is a flavorful Argentinian sauce that can have a variety of uses. It is typically made with fresh parsley or cilantro, oregano, garlic, and olive oil. Chimichurri can be used as a salad dressing or sauce for grilled meats and vegetables. You can use a blender, but to me, it will come out like pesto. Preferably, I'd rather chop the greens.



- Finely chop the Parsley, Green Onion, Cilantro and Garlic.
 Mix them together.
- 3. Stir in Olive Oil, Fresh Lemon Juice, Lemon Zest, Buffalo Sauce, and Red Wine Vinegar.
 - 4. Add Roasted Cumin and Oregano.
 - 5. Season with Salt and Pepper to taste.
 - 6. Mix all the ingredients together.

Olive Oil 1qt

Parsley 1 Bunch, (leaves only)

Cílantro 1 Bunch (leaves only)

Green Onion 6 pcs

Garlíc 2Tbsp.

Lemon Zest 2Tbsp.

Fresh Lime Juice (2 whole Limes)

Franks Buffalo Sauce 2 Tbsp.

Red Wine Vinegar 1Tbsp.

Roasted Cumin ½ Tsp

Oregano 1Tsp

Salt to taste Pepper to taste









Dear Members,

August has brought its normal "Texas" weather, and we were ready! Regardless of mother nature, the agronomy team accomplished some great things. Our final aerification of the year was conducted earlier in the month and went great. A few small projects have been executed as well. Most of late August pushed our focus to tournament preparation and detail work throughout the golf course and practice facility.

The completion of the last aerification of the year is always a huge victory. It's hot, and the staff has been grinding through the heat. We were able to aerify the range and greens on the course throughout the two-day closure, as well as veritcutting most shortcut surfaces. We did decide to use a larger tine for this aerification to ensure ample airflow and gas exchange throughout the soil profile. We have received much-improved soil data in regard to percolation rates from last year to this year due to our aerification practices. We would like to extend our gratitude to the members and their guests for allowing the proper amount of time to conduct these agronomic practices.



Even through the hectic month of August, the team was able to tackle a few projects throughout the golf course. The staff did a great job clearing our debris and trees from around the tip of the waterfall on 18. The black and gold tee box has major irrigation deficiencies in the back left corner. We brought the edge

inward 3 yards to ensure the shortcut turf is being watered adequately. The movement of the tee perimeter will have no impact on play or teeing location but will drastically enhance the turf health on the back edge of the tee box. We cleared all the weeds and tree suckers from the rock wall on the sixth hole. This is an iconic MVCC feature and deserves to shine!





Tournament season is around the corner, and our focus is on providing elite playing surfaces day in and day out. We have been busy with increased mowing frequencies, watering, and detail work. The detail work is the labor-intensive part, with lots of weed-eating and dirty work. The staff has had an amazing attitude regardless of the weather conditions, and I couldn't be more proud to work with such an amazing staff.

While all the staff has worked tirelessly, we do have one standout this month: newcomer Victor Ballesteros. Victor joined the MVCC agronomy team in early July with an amazing work ethic and a high motor, Mr. Ballesteros works non-stop. He has truly helped elevate our team, and the management staff and his coworkers are so thankful for his hard work. If you see Victor around, please congratulate him on all his hard work!
