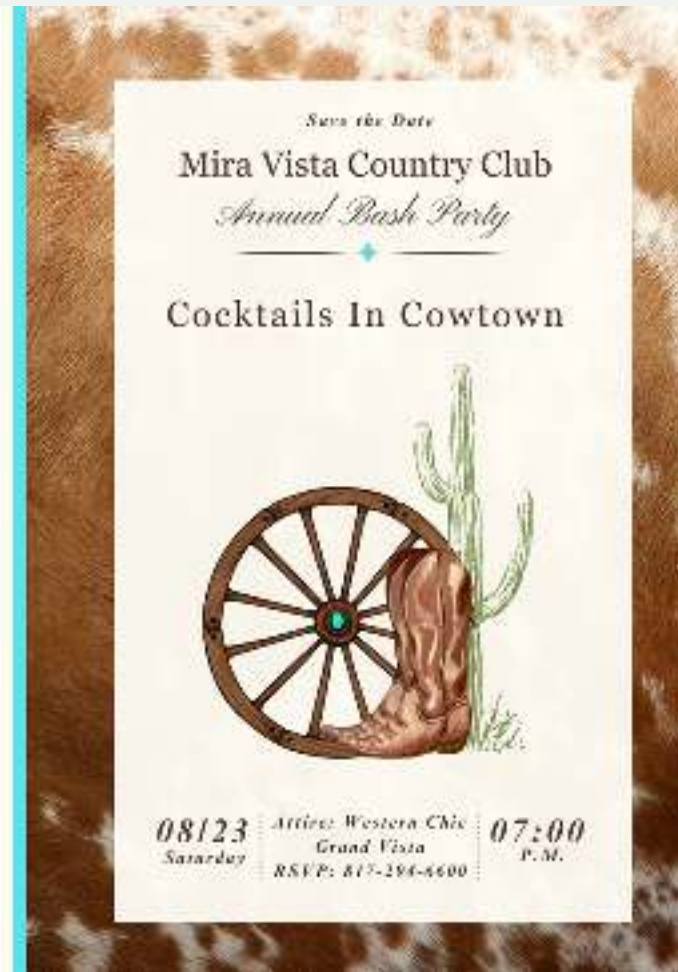

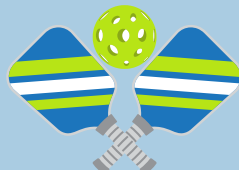
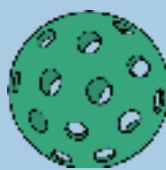

Lemon-Tarragon Yogurt Crusted Halibut

Serves 4

Chef recently released his new dining room menu, featuring fresh summer inspired dishes, including the standout Lemon Tarragon Yogurt Crusted Halibut.

Ingredients

Halibut

4 halibut fillets (6-7 oz each)

For the Yogurt Mixture:

1 quart plain yogurt

1 tablespoon dried tarragon, finely chopped

1 tablespoon fresh chopped parsley

1 tablespoon lemon zest (best done with a micro plane)

2 tablespoons lemon juice

2 tablespoons honey

1 tablespoon kosher salt

2 teaspoons cracked black pepper

For the Breadcrumb Topping:

2 cups panko breadcrumbs

¼ cup melted butter

¼ cup grated Parmesan cheese

1 tablespoon fresh chopped parsley

Instructions

1. Prepare the Yogurt Mixture:

Place the yogurt in a strainer basket lined with a double layer of paper towels. Cover with plastic wrap and let sit for 1 hour to drain excess water and thicken the yogurt.

After straining, transfer yogurt to a mixing bowl. Add the tarragon, parsley, lemon zest, lemon juice, honey, salt, and pepper. Mix well to combine.

2. Make the Breadcrumb Topping:

Melt butter in a pan over low heat, being careful not to brown it. Once cooled to room temperature, mix in panko, Parmesan, and parsley. Stir until evenly combined.

3. Assemble and Cook:

Spoon the yogurt mixture over the tops of the halibut fillets, spreading evenly.

Top each fillet with the breadcrumb mixture, lightly pressing it down to fully cover the yogurt.

Place fillets in a well-oiled baking dish or sheet pan.

Roast in a preheated oven at 350°F for 15-20 minutes, depending on thickness.

Fish is done when the crust is golden brown and the halibut flakes easily with a fork.
